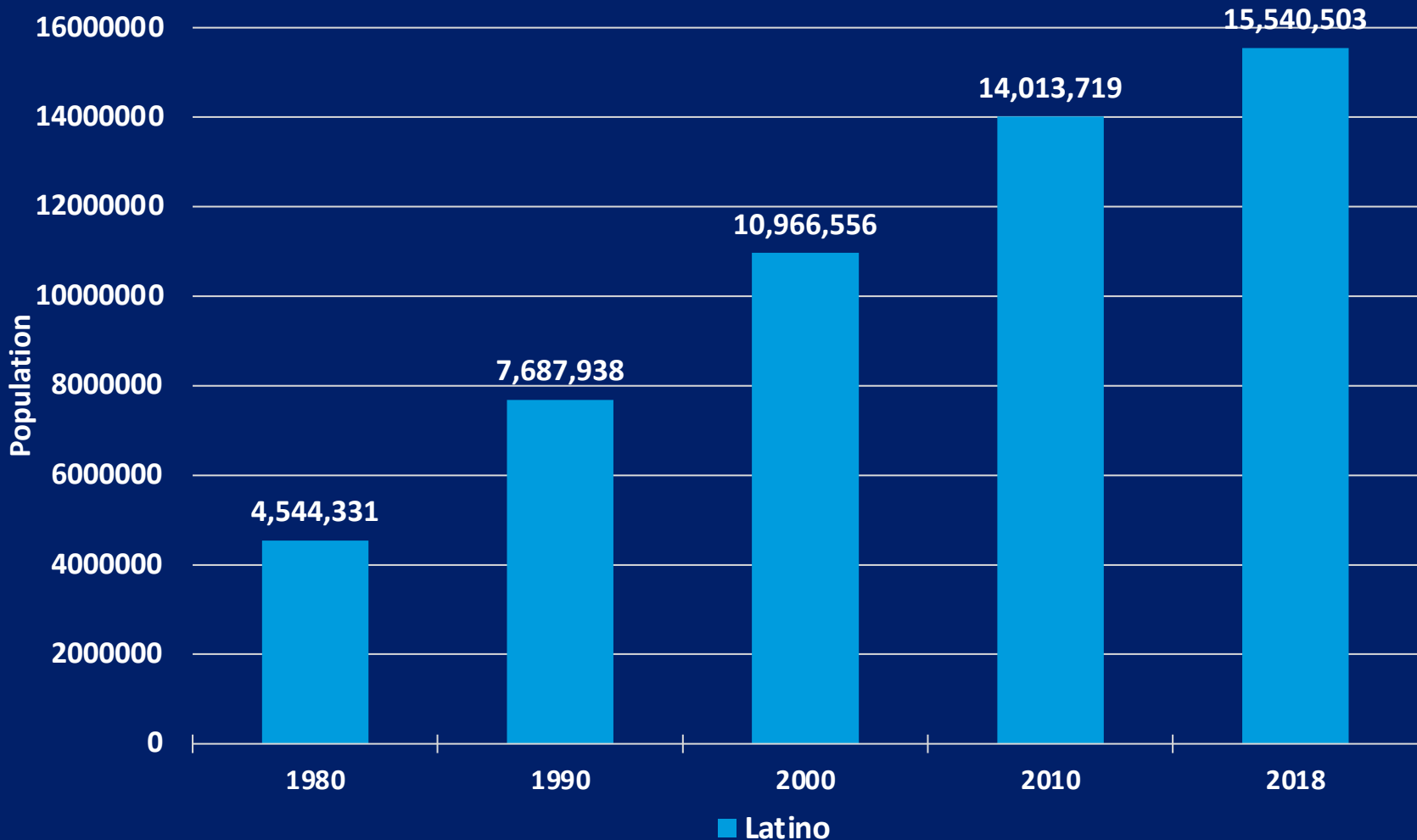


Latino Population Change, California 1980-2018

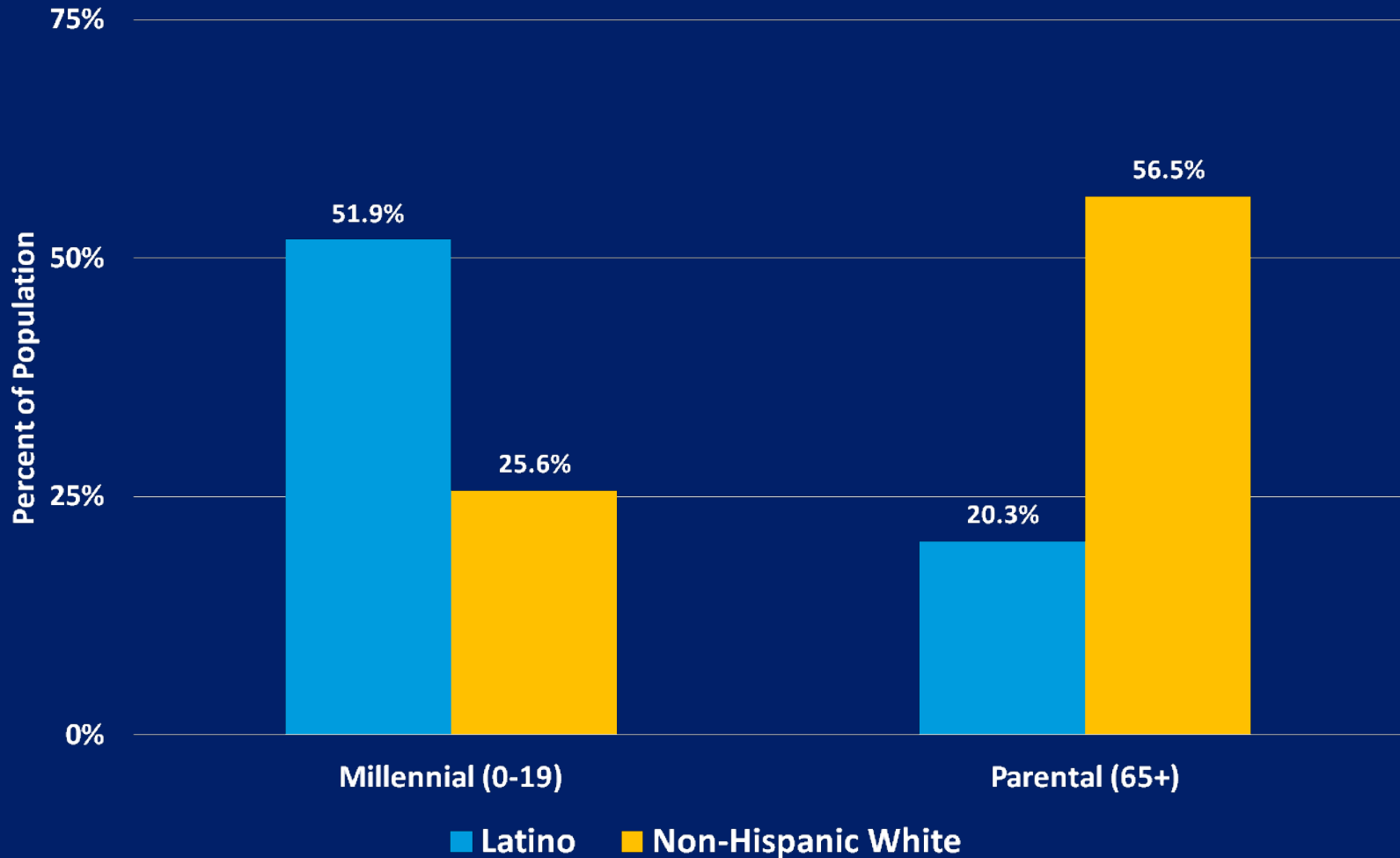


Younger Latinos, Older Non-Hispanic Whites, California 2018

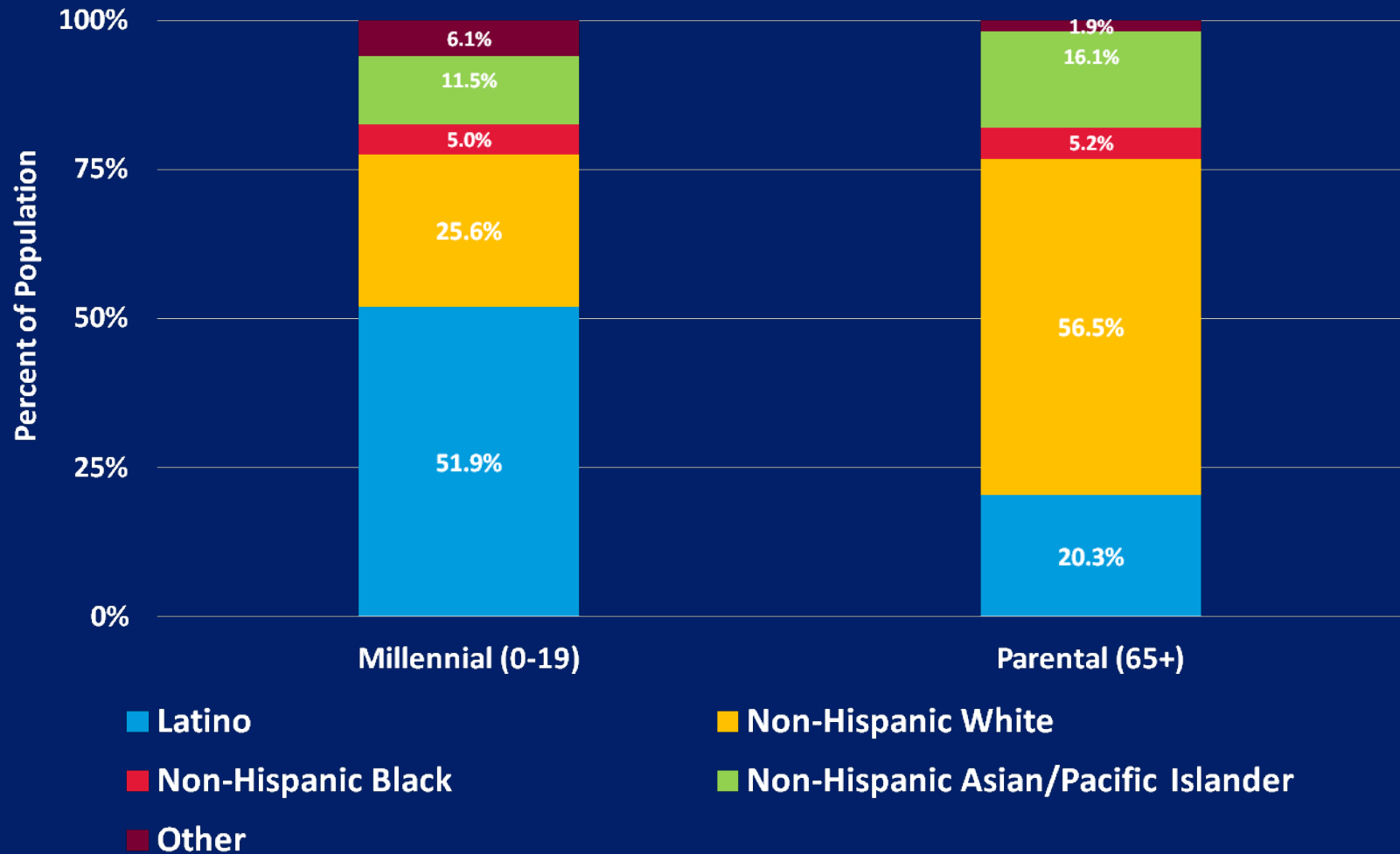
- Elderly - majority are non-Hispanic White

Millennial and Parental Age, By Race/Ethnicity, California 2018

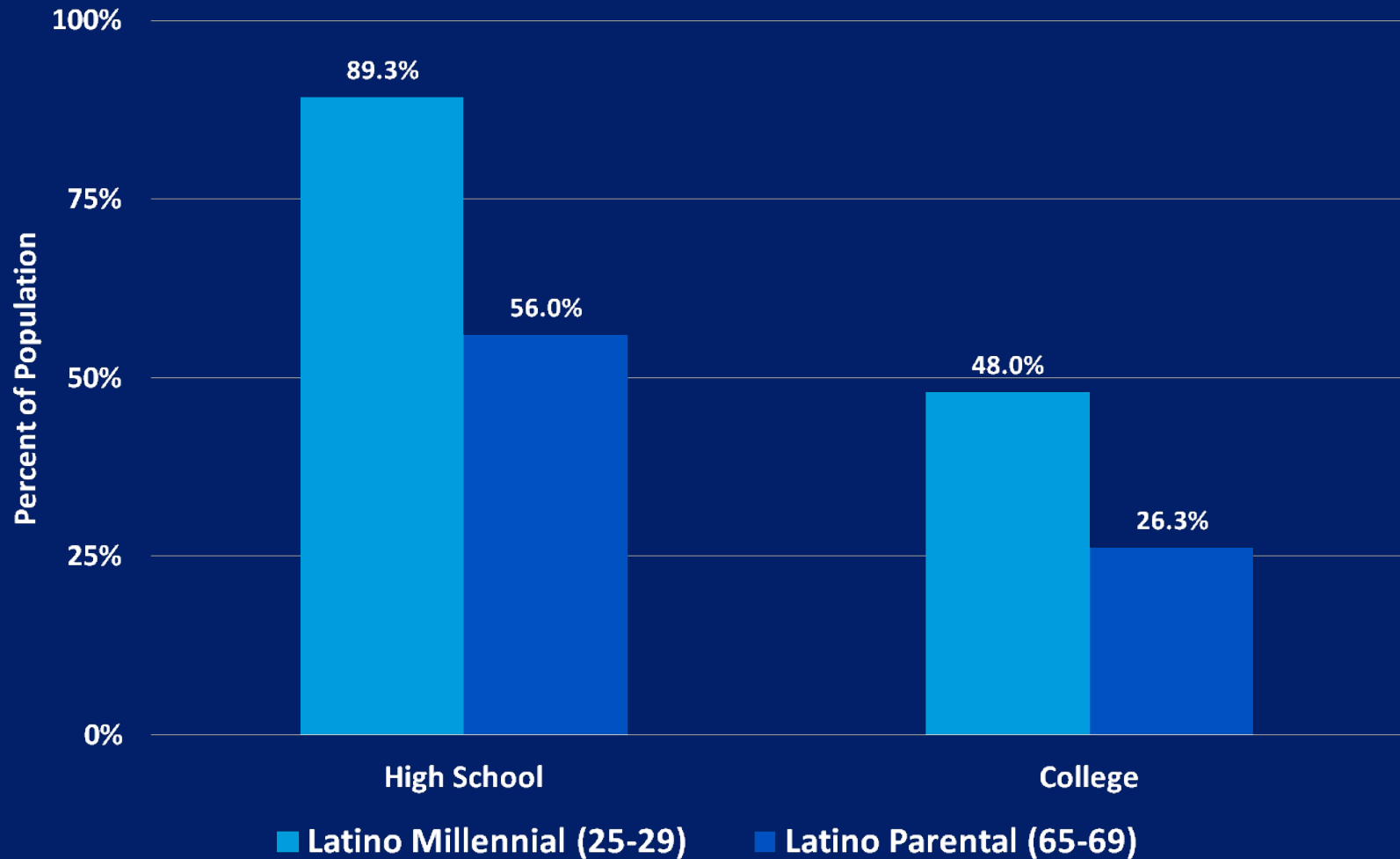


Educational Increase, Latino Millennials over Latino Parental Generation, California 2018

Latino High School and Latino College Attendance, Millennial and Parental Generation, California 2018

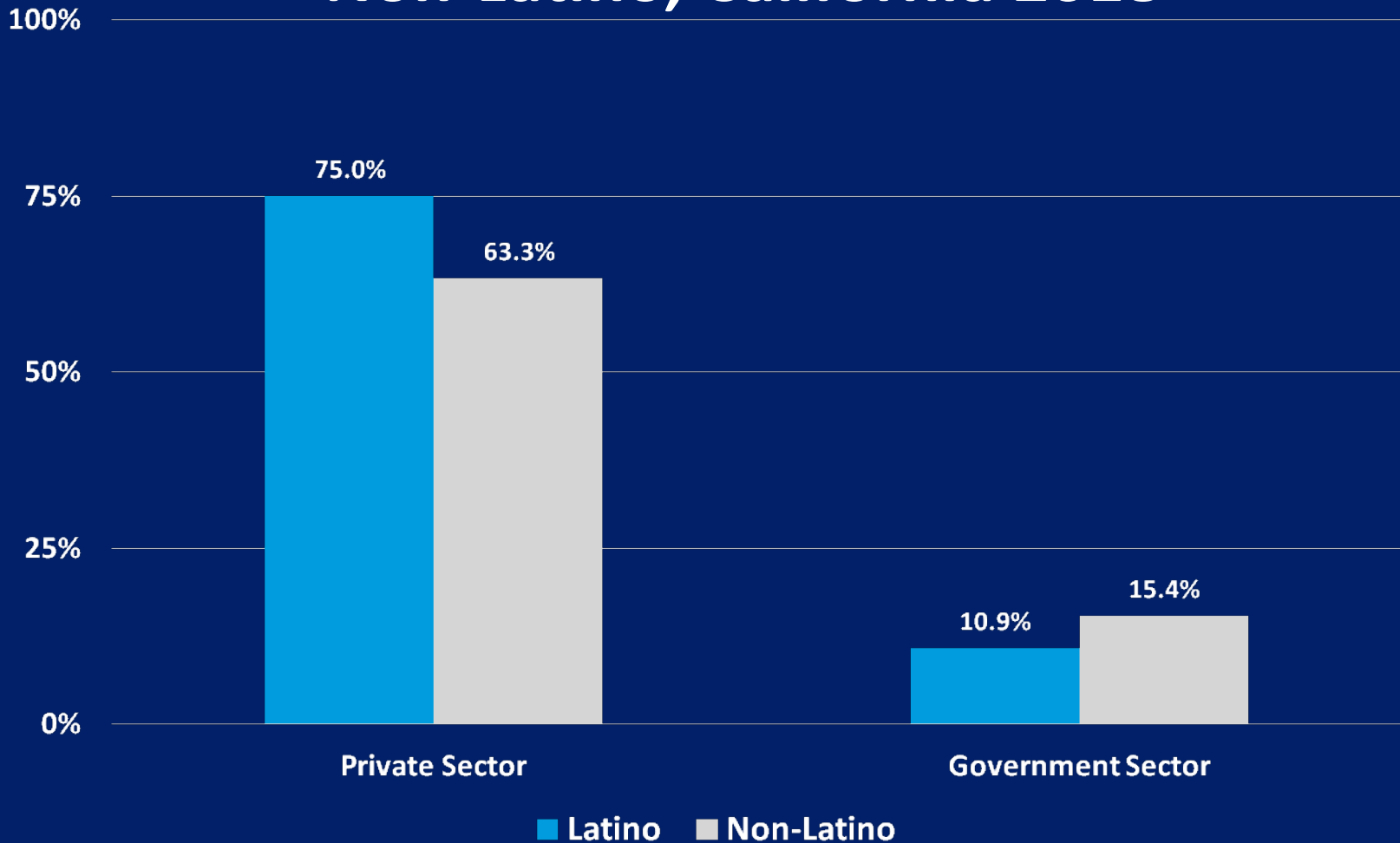


Self-Sufficiency in Employment, California 2018

Self-Sufficiency – Private Sector And Government Sector Employment, Latino and Non-Latino, California 2018

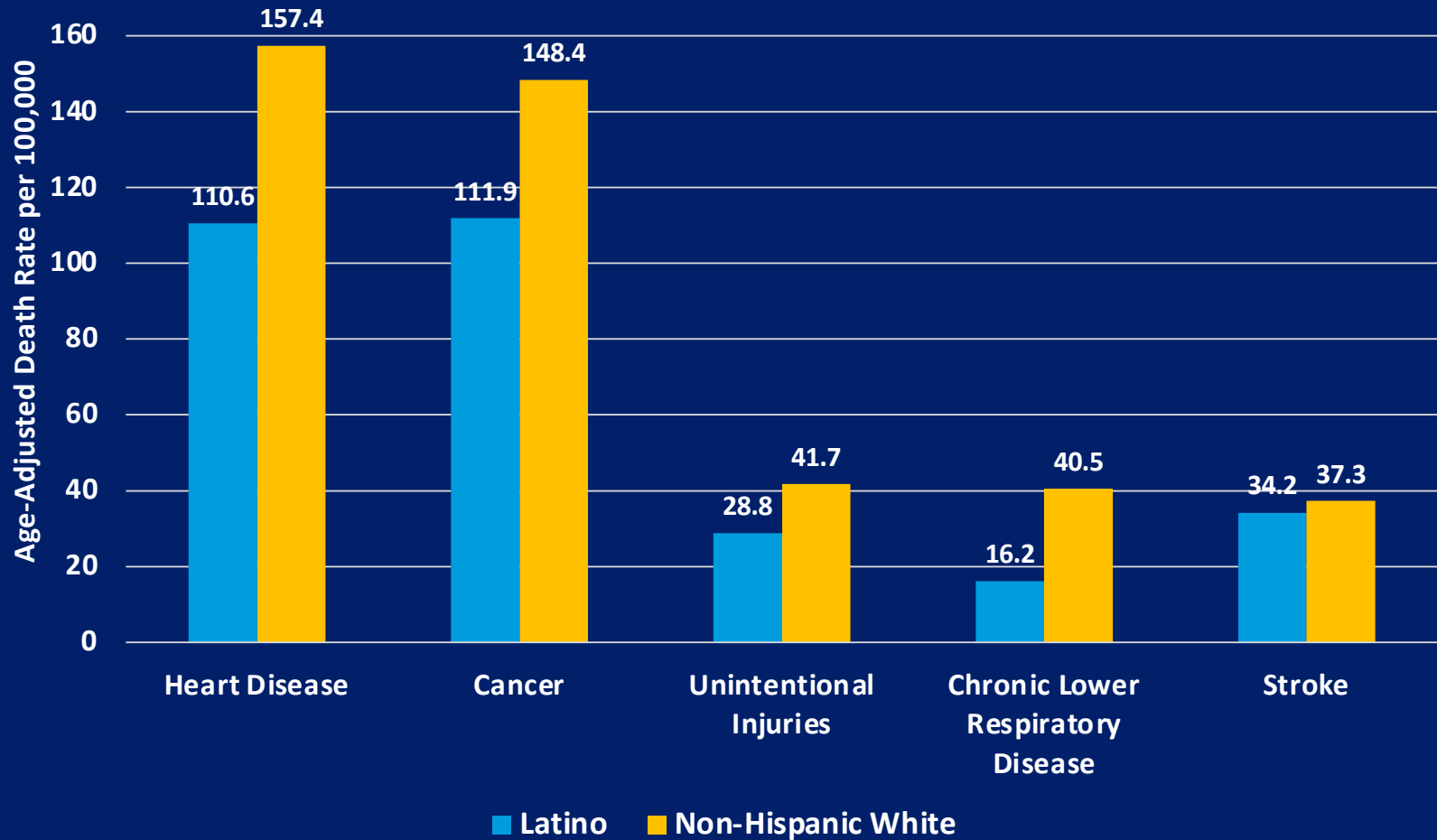


Healthy Profile, United States, 2019

Age-Adjusted Death Rates, Latino and Non-Hispanic White, California 2018

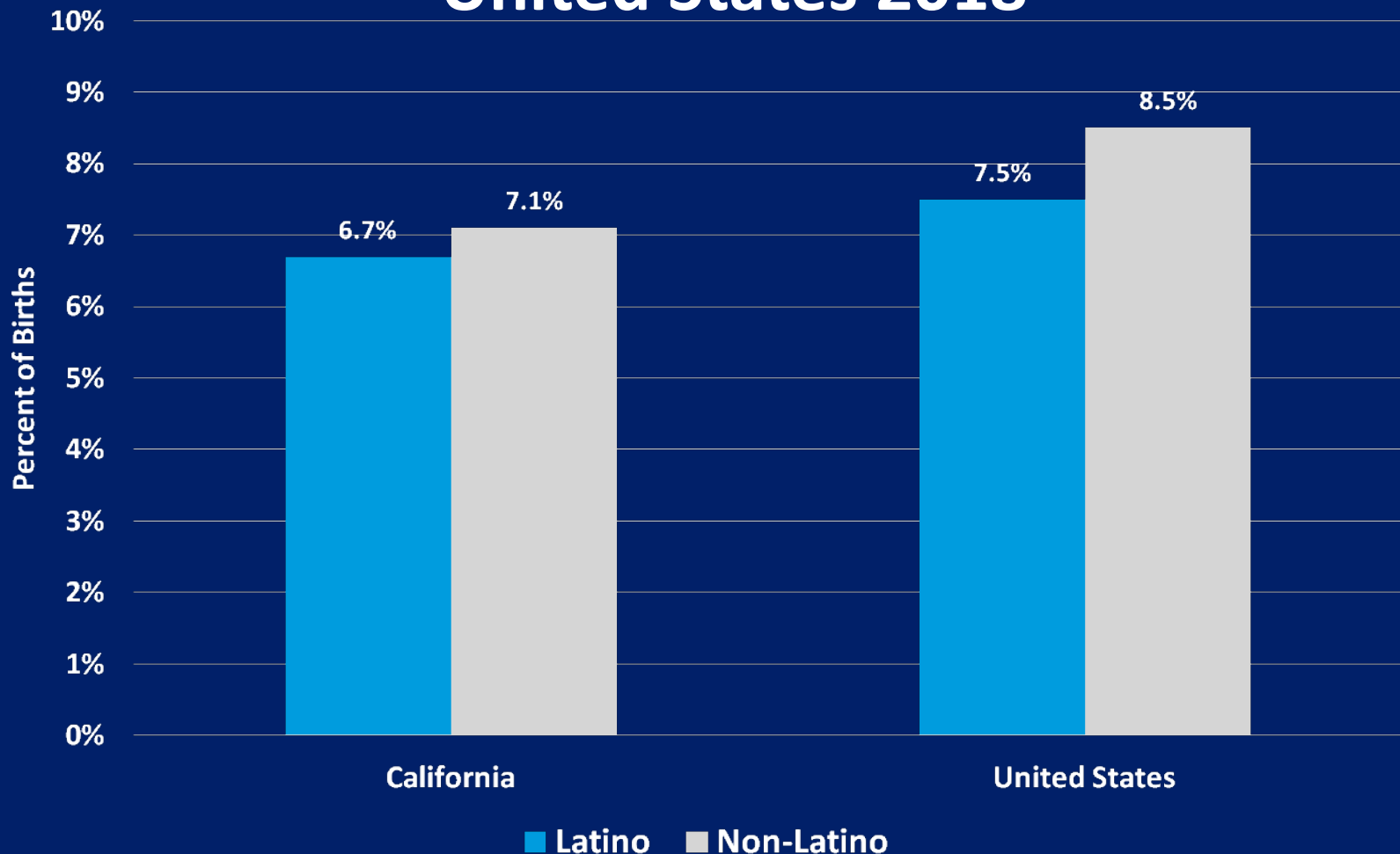


Healthy Profile, California 2018

Healthy Babies – Percent Born with Low Birth Weight, Latino and Non-Latino, California and United States 2018

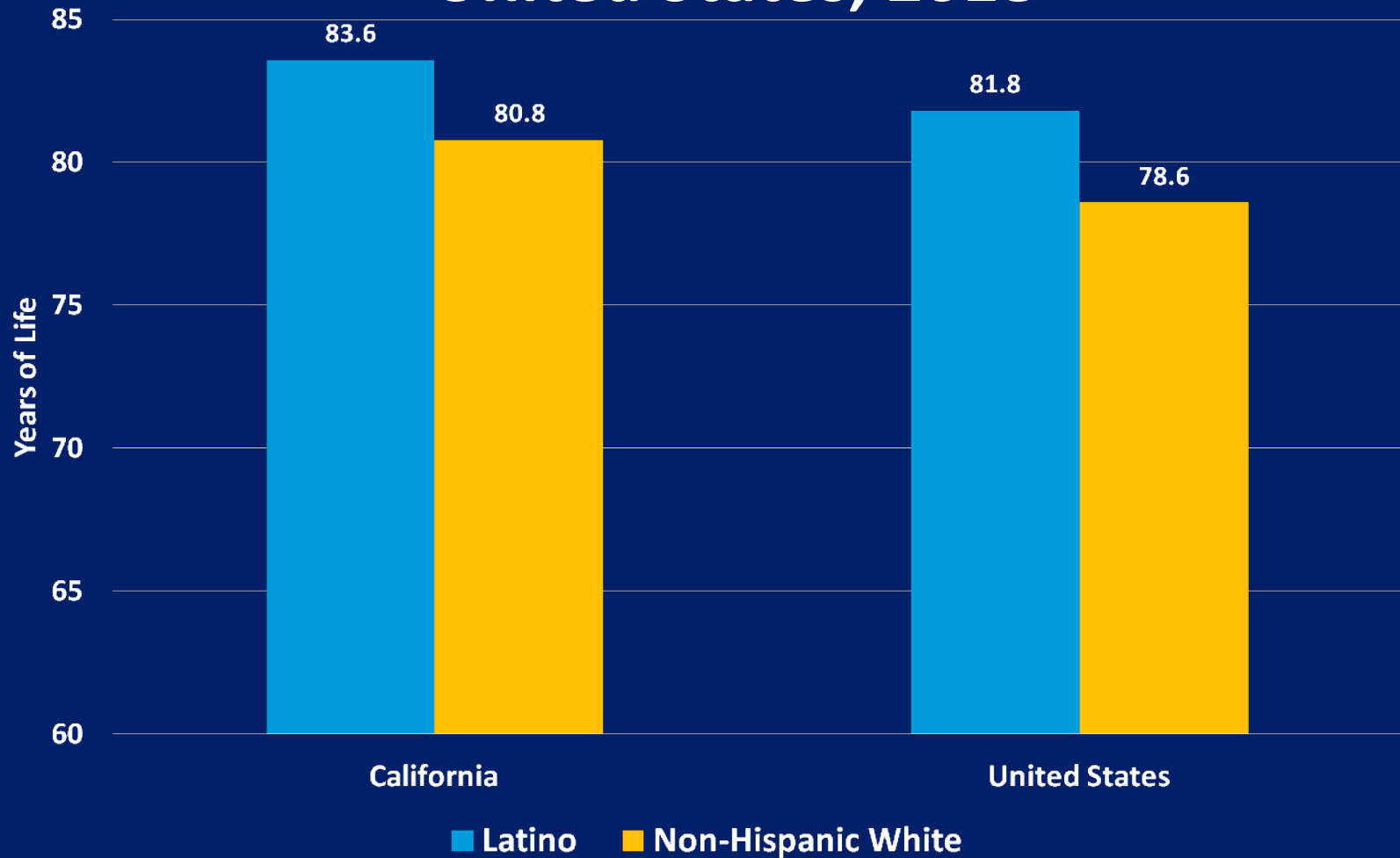


Healthy Profile, California 2018

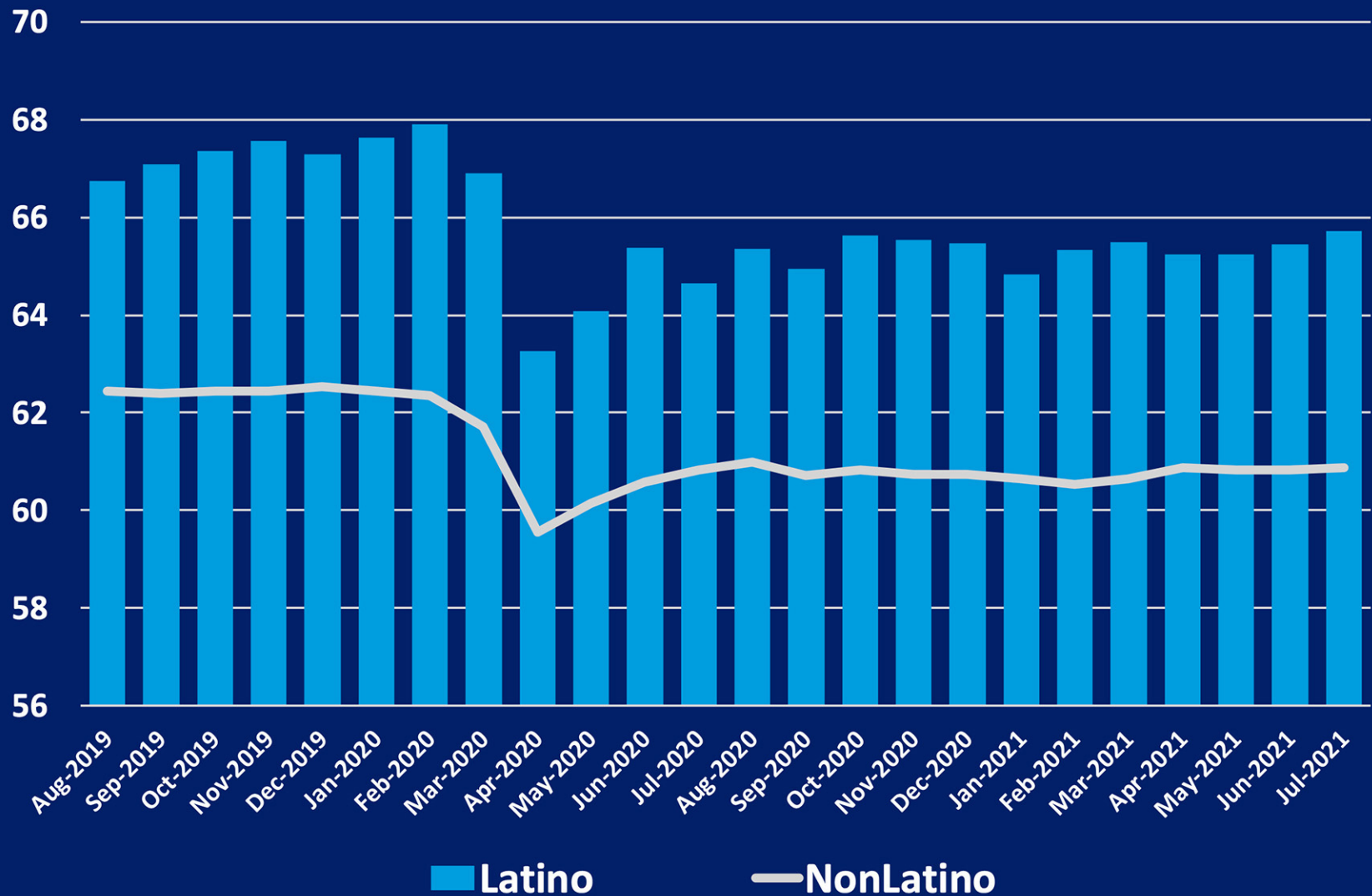

Labor Force Participation Rate

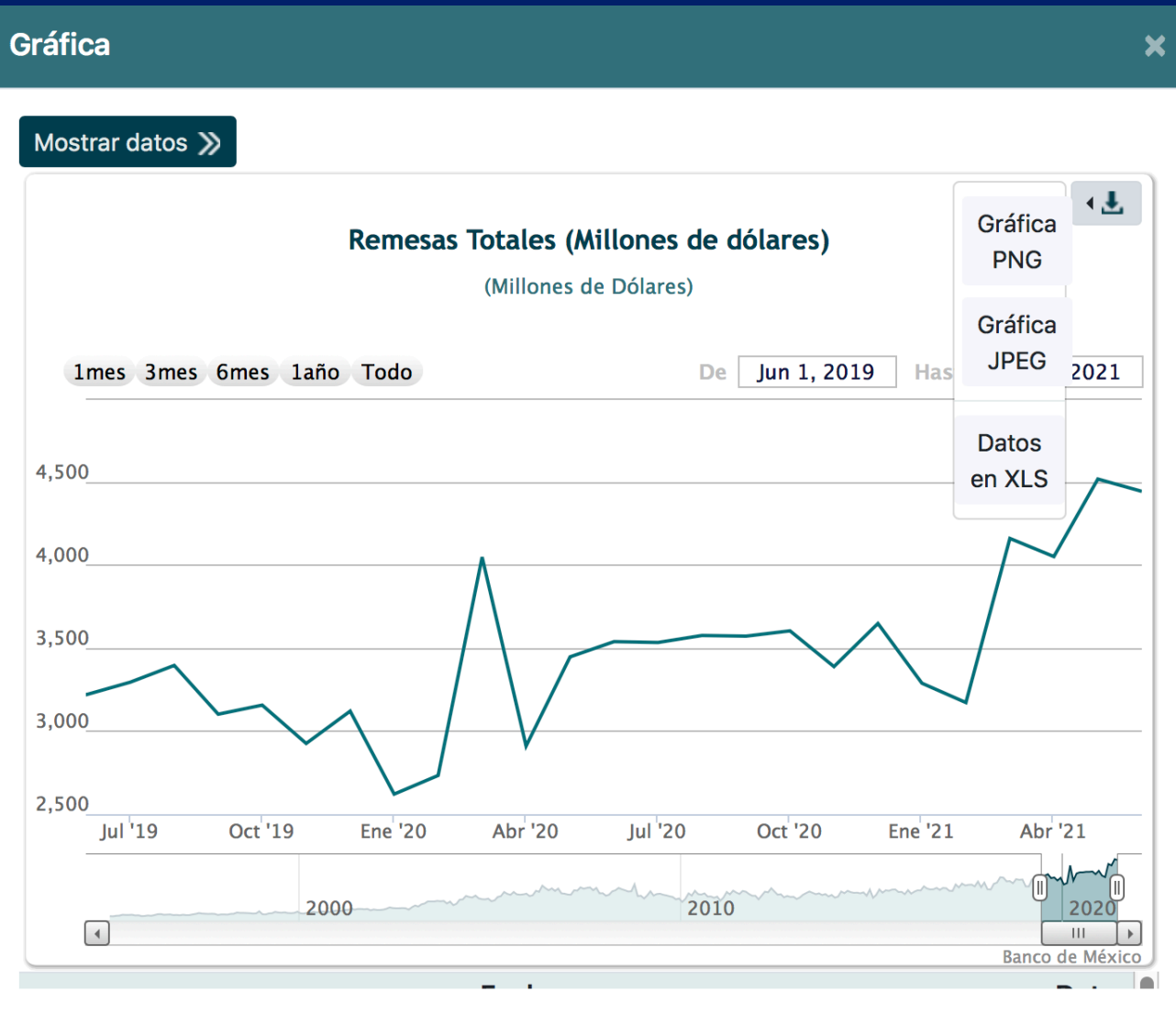

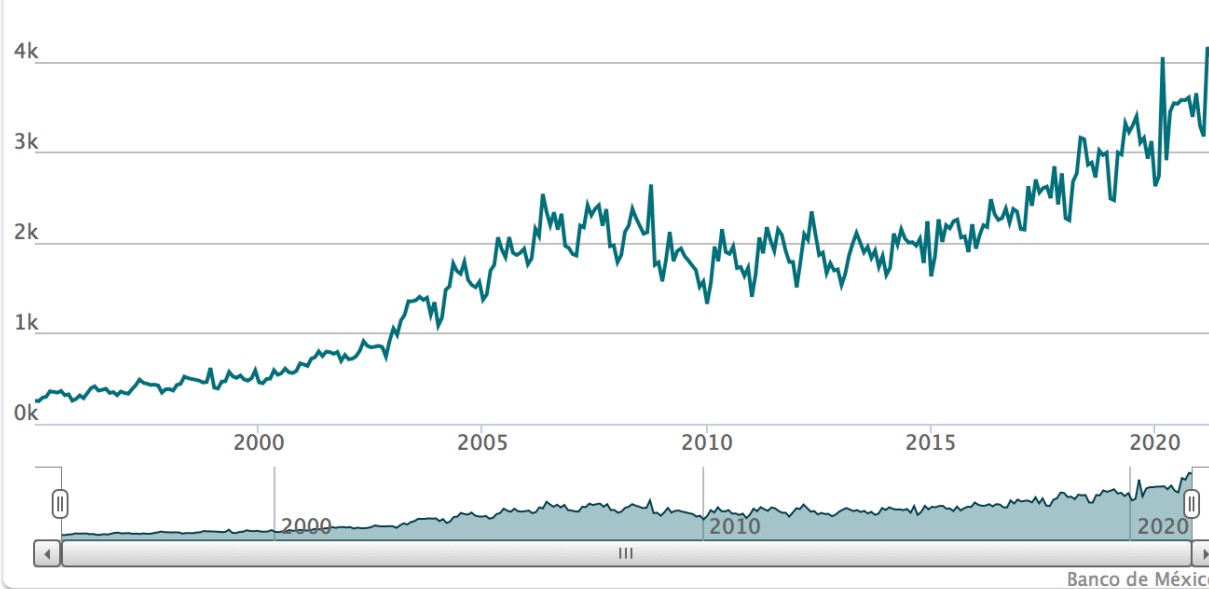

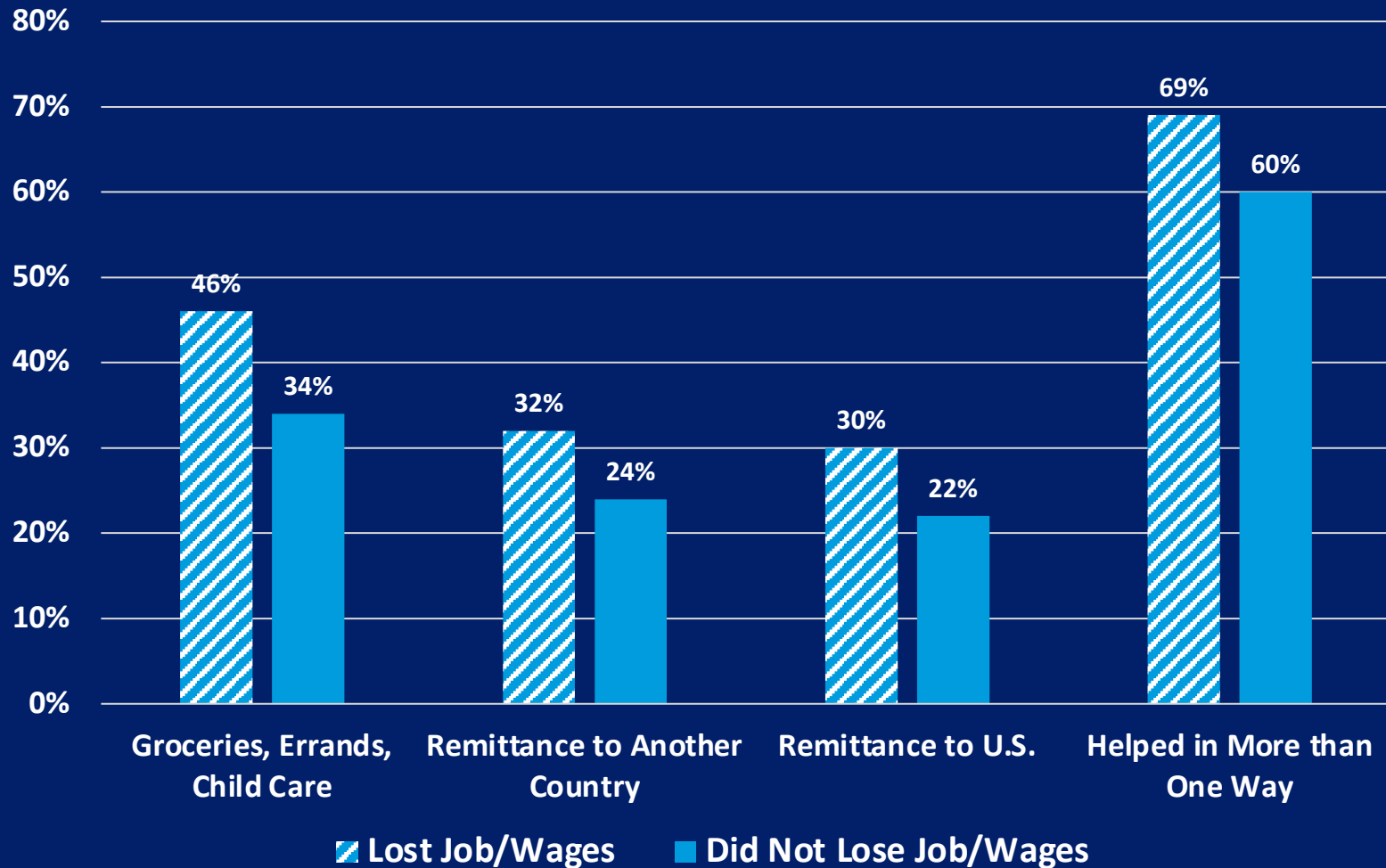

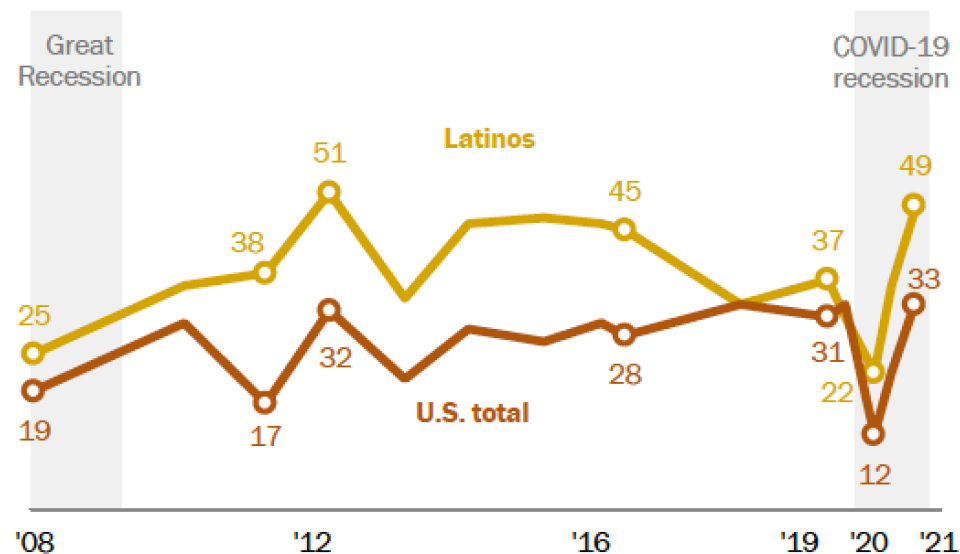
